At one point in time we gather to protest that the basic right of safe and suitable housing is not available to everyone. Sunday, April 27, 2025 12:00pm

Registration, music, community group informational tables and refreshments as approximately 500 participants prepare to take to the streets of downtown New London in the spirit of care.

1:00 pm

The Walk kicks off as participants follow a leisurely 1.6 mile, 45 minute walk throughout downtown and along the waterfront. Participants appreciate the camaraderie of people who care about eliminating homelessness in our community, build relationships and takes steps toward a solution.
